2018 Legislative Session - Policy Issues

- 1. <u>Bonding:</u> Legislative prohibition on bonding of I-405 toll revenue (North and South).
- 2. <u>Build out the Approved I-405 Master Plan</u> (see Fiscal Issues below).
- 3. Give Us our Lane Back: A bill to
 - a. Remove the Express Toll Lanes (ETL) designation on I-405 north of Bellevue,
 - b. Change one ETL in each direction between Bellevue and Bothell to general purpose lanes, and
 - c. Restore the single 2+ HOV lanes, with treatments to reduce friction.
- 4. Toll Policy Bill: Repeal legislative intent language for ETL pilot projects and eventual expansion.
- 5. <u>Connect WA funded I-405</u>, <u>Bellevue to Renton</u>: Design and operation for single 2+ HOV lanes.

2018 Legislative Session - Fiscal Issues

- 1. Supplemental Budget for Transportation Construction cost for:
 - a. NB I-405, SR 520 add lane end to NE 70th St. (Bellevue/Kirkland)
 - b. SB I-405, NE 116th St, to NE 85th St. (Kirkland)
 - c. SB I-405, I-5 to NE 195th St. (Lynnwood/Bothell)
 - d. Budget Proviso: Prohibit spending of bonded toll revenues (in lieu of policy bill).
